Richard Hutten, licenciado en 1991 por la Design Academy Eindhoven, forma parte de la generación de jóvenes diseñadores que propiciaron el caldo de cultivo del que surgiría Droog Design. Vinculado a este grupo desde su fundación en 1993, Hutten es un diseñador de producto de gran éxito en el ámbito asiático, especialmente Japón. Este creador de 42 años tiene piezas en las colecciones permanentes de museos como el San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, el Vitra Museum en Weil am Rhein o el Stedelijk Museum en Amsterdam. Conocido por sus colaboraciones con Vivid, Hutten ha aceptado encargos de clientes prestigiosos, entre los que se cuentan IDÉE Tokyo, Donna Karan, Philippe Starck o incluso la Reina Beatriz de Holanda. Richard Hutten es célebre por el desarrollo de sus conceptos *No sign of design* y *Table upon table* y, en la actualidad, está preparando su primer libro, *Works in use*. Richard Hutten—who graduated from the Design Academy Eindhoven in 1991—forms part of the generation of young designers who helped to bring about the favourable environment from which Droog Design emerged. A key exponent of this collective, in which he has been involved since its inception in 1993, Hutten is a product designer who enjoys great success, particularly in Japan and the Asian market. The work of this 42-year-old artist forms part of the permanent collections of, among others, the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the Vitra Museum in Weil am Rhein and the Stedelijk Museum in Amsterdam. Renowned for his collaboration with Vivid, Hutten has also executed commissions for prestigious clients, including IDÉE Tokyo, Donna Karan, Philippe Starck and even Queen Beatrix, the ruler of the Netherlands. Richard Hutten, who is famous for the development of concepts such as *No sign of design* and *Table upon table*, is currently busy preparing his first book, *Works in use*.
